### Driving and Parking Facilities

160 Bourke Rd provides the most direct access to the centre and main car park.

Patrons are entitled to 3-hours free parking per day within the surrounding precinct car park. The following rates apply past 3-hours:

Bus stops along Gardeners Road and O'Riordan Street (8-minute walk)

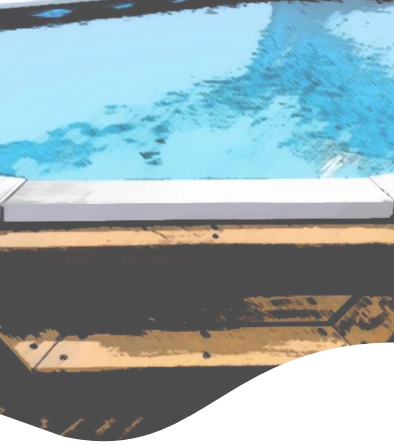

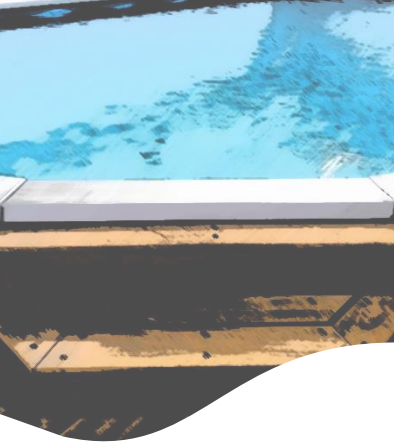

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### LESSONS - WHAT TO WEAR AND BRING

#### BUBSthrive (under 3's)

Little Heroes Swim Academy implements a double-layer policy for all BUBSthrive students. The first layer consists of a dedicated disposable swim nappy; the second layer **MUST** be sealed - firm and elasticised is best - around waistband and legs for containment of any potential contamination.

#### Considerations for other students

Additionally, for students of any age that are either not yet toilet trained or physically unable to control, a double-layer policy will also apply. The first layer needs to be suitably secure as the primary containment measure for a contamination. The second layer is backup should an accident occur.

**Please note that students with an unsuitable secondary layer may be refused entry into the pool.** The quality of our water and the health of our students is of paramount importance to us. Our stance on secondary layers is firm to protect against a contamination in the pool and the subsequent necessary treatment (pool evacuation and closure for up to 24 hours).

#### Goggles

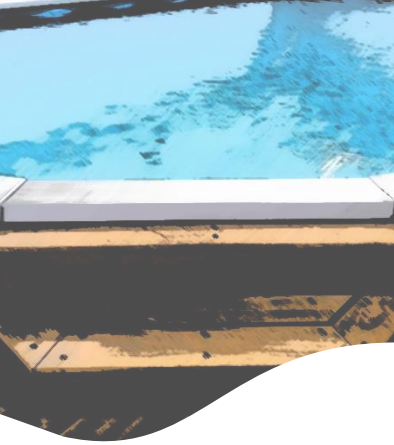
Goggles are generally a good idea once students are in classes on their own with a mentor. Unless your child has a significant aversion to goggles, they will enhance your child's experience in the water. Part of our curriculum involves swimming without goggles too, with the intention of students not being too reliant on them to swim.

Don't have any yet? No problem, we have a range of quality Head goggles available for purchase. Come and see our front desk to check out your options.

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## LHSA Enrolment Terms and Conditions

### ONGOING ENROLMENTS - We run all year round!

#### What are ongoing enrolments?

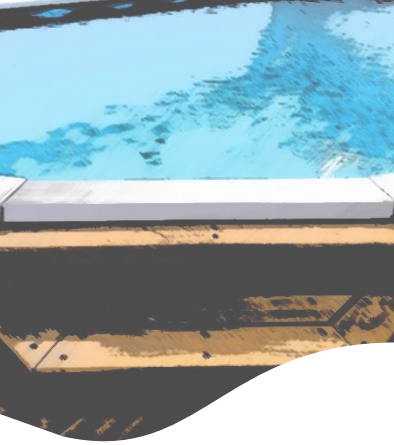
Lessons run all-year round, only breaking for End of Year closure over Christmas and New Year (generally two weeks). Instead of re-enrolling each school term, students will be enrolled into their chosen time and day which will remain until they either move up a level or a change/cancellation is requested.

Ongoing assessments will be undertaken by Little Heroes to ensure your child is in a level that allows them to thrive.

### LESSON FEES – Schedule and Payment Methods

- Lesson fees (charges) are recorded on the **1st of each month** and are **due on the 14th of each month**.
- Fees are calculated by the number of scheduled lessons for the calendar month
- Lessons do not run on Public Holidays, and End of Year closures. Fees do not apply for enrolments falling on/within these dates.
- **Required Recurring Billing (direct-debit)** – families are required to have a valid bank account or credit card with Recurring Billing enabled (setup via the Member Portal or iClass Pro app). On the 14th of each month, the Recurring Billing task will debit any **outstanding amounts for the current month**. ([Click here to see How to Setup Recurring Billing](#))
- **Manual Payments** - credit card, direct bank transfer or cash payments can still be made but must be done prior to the 14th of each month, before the regular Recurring Billing debit is performed.





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### ABSENCES – Credits and Make-up Lessons

#### General Absences

In addition to the Xmas and New Year closure, families with active enrolments have access to complimentary credits (conditional on enrolment location) for \*\*notified absences:

- Heroes House, Alexandria enrolments receive two (2) complimentary credits per calendar year
- Souths Jrs, Kingsford enrolments receive six (6) complimentary credits per calendar year

*\*\* Absences must be notified at least 6 hours before the scheduled lesson and can be done via the Little Heroes Member Portal, Mobile App or emailing [info@littleheroesswimacademy.org](mailto:info@littleheroesswimacademy.org).*

- Complimentary credits are provided as a credit amount on your family ledger, equal to the value of approved notified lesson absences. Credits may be used separately or consecutively at a family's discretion.
- Once all complimentary credits are used within the calendar year, lessons missed due to non-medical absences will be generally forfeited.

#### Make-up Policy

We understand that missing classes is inevitable. Contrary to many programs, we do offer make-up lessons under the following conditions:

- Make-up lessons for notified absences are subject to availability
- No guarantees are implied or given for the availability of make-up lessons

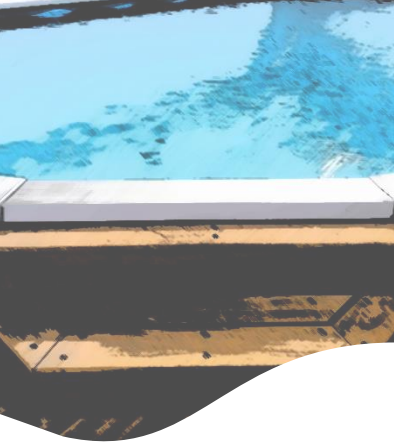
Little Heroes highly values our industry-leading low student to teacher ratios, and providing a viable make-up policy is helped by families paying it forward. By notifying your child's absence, you create availability for another family to potentially benefit from a make-up.

#### Medical Absences

Credits will be provided for extended medical absences under the following conditions:

- Absences are notified in advance (unless a later diagnosis is received)
- Extended absences are considered as **two (2) or more consecutive absences**
- Extended medical absences are recorded separate to complimentary credits. If make-up lessons are preferred in lieu of a credit, the normal make-up policy will apply





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### EXTENDED BREAKS AND CANCELLATIONS

#### Extended Break

If a family has used their allotted complimentary credits, additional or extended breaks will be charged at 50% to retain the enrolment for a maximum of four (4) additional weeks.

#### Cancellations

Cancellations can be requested at any time during the year. To cancel an enrolment, we require two (2) weeks notice either in person or via email and the family account must not be in arrears.



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
